Nabeel Rajab (no. 16): President of the Bahrain Centre for Human Rights . The riot police and civilian clothed hooded men took me into the jeep and they were swearing at me and swearing at the opposition. They kept threatening to rape me, one sitting next to me kept touching me. They kept calling me “baltaji”. They also used Sectarian swearing saying “you Shiaa should leave this country”. One of them told me to say that I love the prime minister and that I want him in power. They then started beating me in the car. One of them kicked me in the face with his boots. They were punching, kicking

and slapping. I insisted not to say I want the prime minister. The handcuffs were so tight it left marks on my hands. They put me in another car after a while; I was blindfolded and did not know where I was. They told me “we already raped Hassan Musheima and you’re next”. When we were in the other car they removed my blindfold and handcuffs. We were headed to Riffa area and I assumed I was being taken to the military, but then they got a phone call and sped to the investigation directorate instead. The head of investigation came and said “we brought u to ask you if you know if this person has a gun” and he told me the name of the person. I told them that I don’t know him. I told him we’re against violence and if he has a gun then we’re against it. The head of the investigation directory seemed to be in a hurry to get me out of there and so he ended the conversation quickly. Then they took me home returning everything except my wallet.

Salah Abdulla Al-Khawaja (no. 21): was arrested around 3 o’clock early morning Monday 21 March 2011. During the arrest, His wife, Fatma Sayyed, was beaten by five security men in front of her 4 children. His youngest, Ruqaya, aged 6, hasn't stopped crying since his arrest. His house was searched and missed up and the tires of his car were slashed. His whereabouts are unknown. Apparently, the direct cause of the arrest was the interviews Salah Alkhawaja has been giving to Arabic TV satellite channels on what has been happening in Bahrain; speaking about people beaten in the streets, the detainees and rights of the people in general. He has been taking a role of a human rights defender including documenting cases of death and casualties directly from Salmaniya hospital to the Bahrain Centre for Human Rights (BCHR).
